## SILVER CERTIFICATE

A depiction of one of the most artistically-inspired series of antique U.S. currency, marking the nation's achievements and history. The bills were designed by prominent American artists and feature personified Neo-Classical motifs. They are considered to be some of the most beautiful monetary designs ever produced by the U.S. The bills were redeemable for their face value of silver coins, and are still recognised as valid legal tender today.

Timothy Oulton's Silver Certificate Art is printed on museum-quality archival paper, framed in black wood with tempered glass.



*Running Antelope (1899): Chief Running Antelope became leader of the Hunkpapa tribe in 1851 and was a close advisor to Sitting Bull during the Prairie Indian Wars. A brave warrior, Running Antelope was also a great orator and diplomat, and was one of many Sioux chiefs to sign the historic Treaty of 1868. The \$5 certificate is the only piece of American currency where a Native American is depicted, and became one of the most popular notes.*
