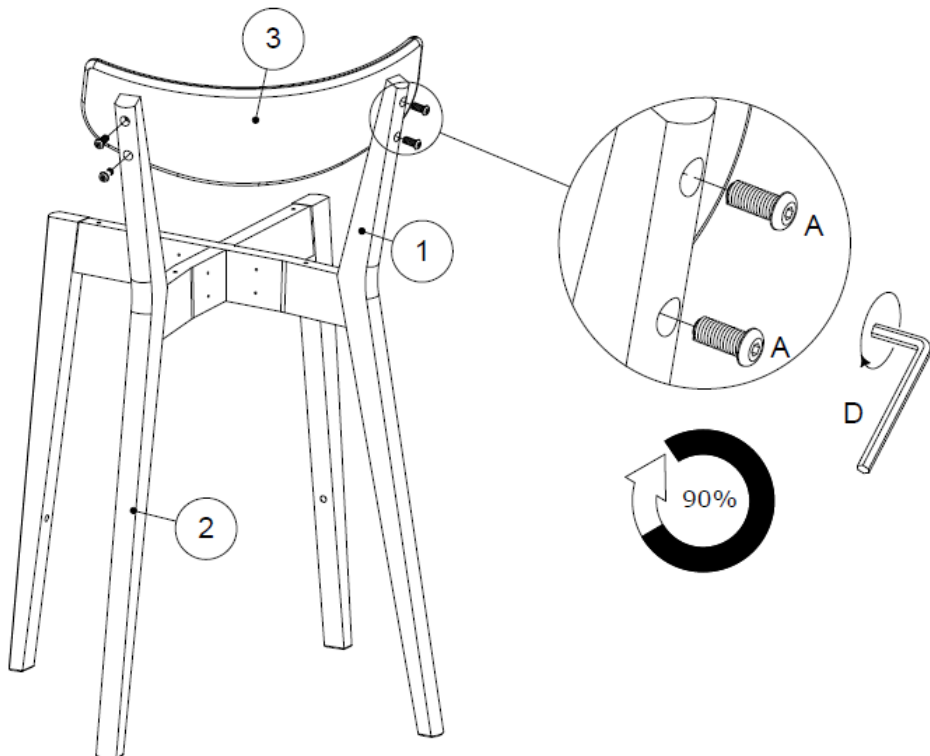
Step 1

Slot both leg frames (1) and (2) together as below.



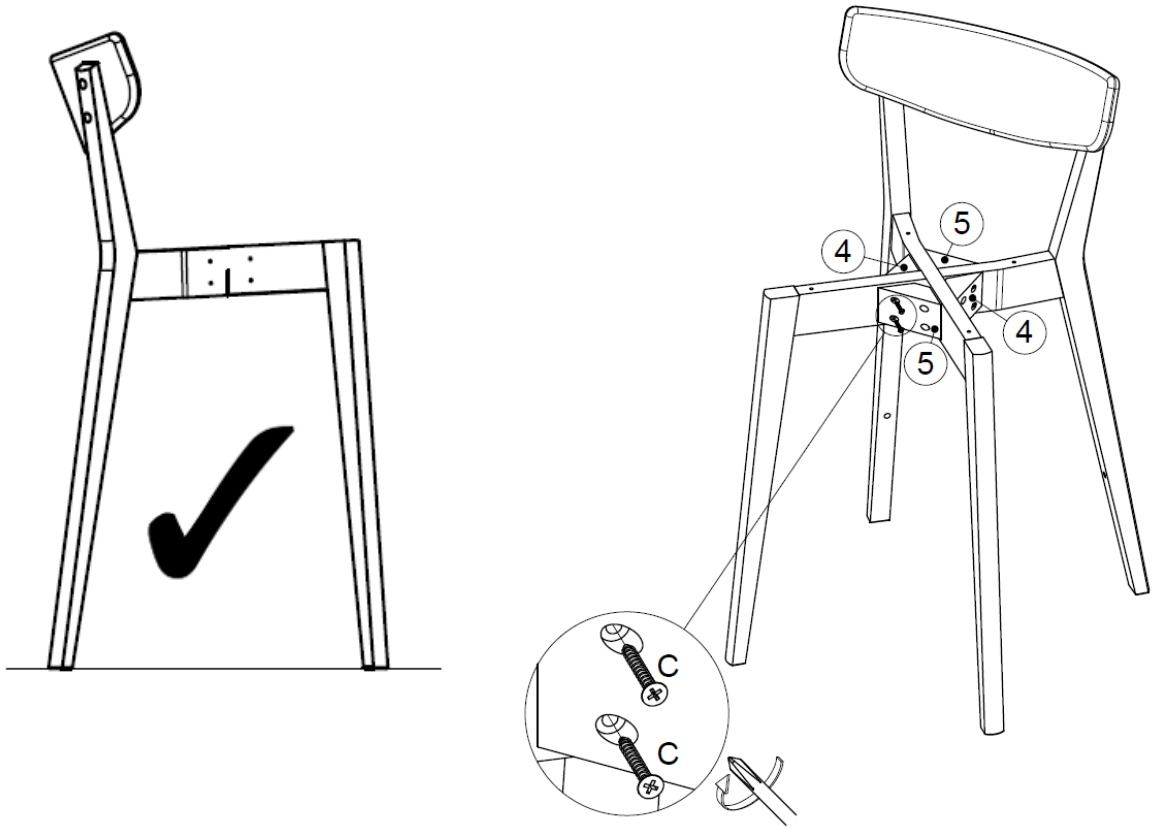
Step 2

Attach the back of the stool (3) to the top of the assembled frame and fasten with bolts (A). Don't tighten fully until the stool is sitting level (step 4).



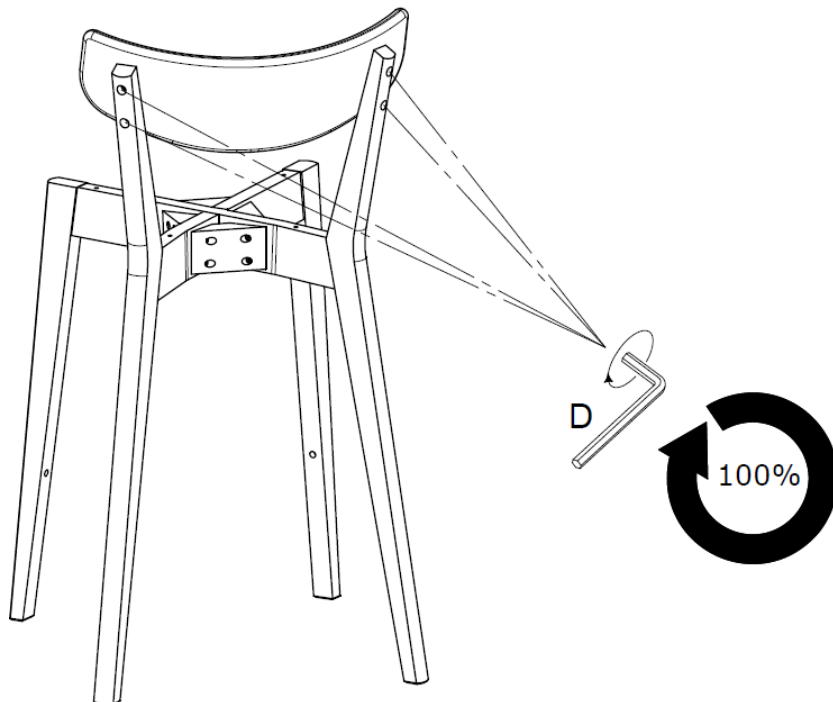
Step 3

Make sure the legs are sitting level on the floor then attach inserts (4) and (5) into adjacent corners of the leg frame and fasten with screws (C).



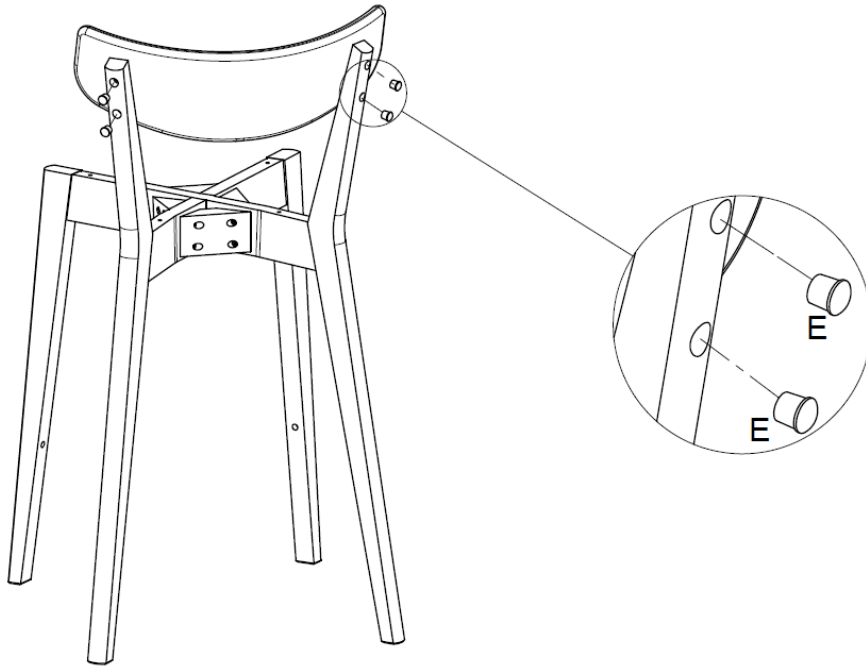
Step 4

With the stool sitting level, fully tighten the bolts on the back.



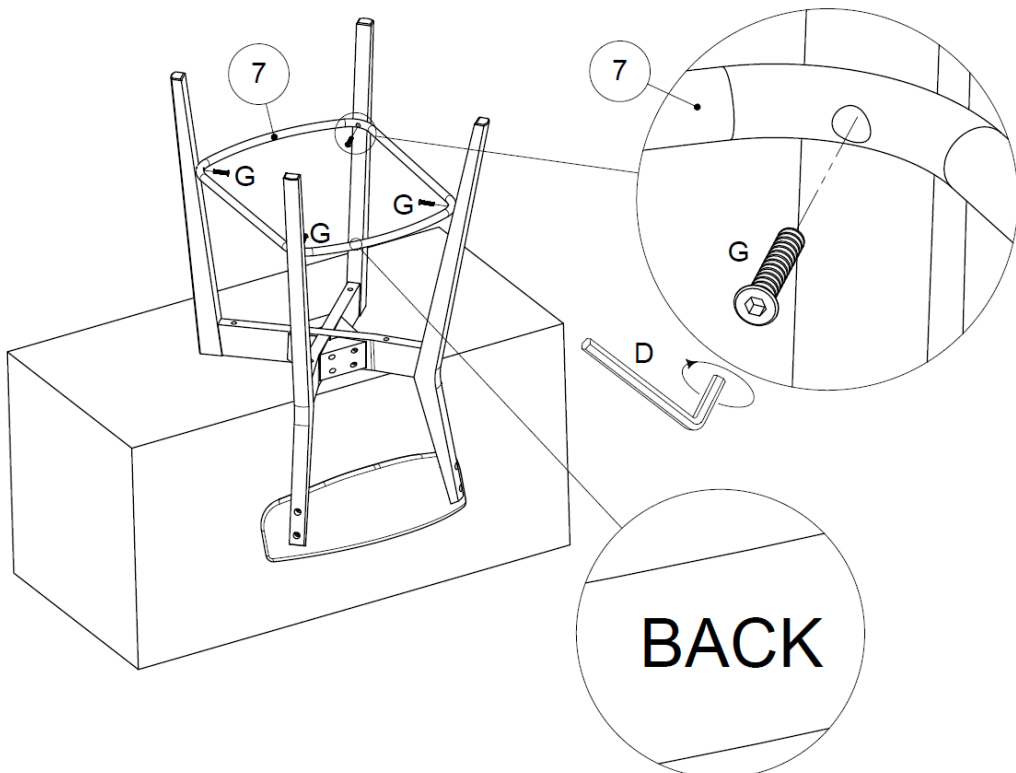
Step 5

Insert the caps (E) to cover bolts.



Step 6

Turn the stool upside down and position the leg support (7) in line with the holes. Attach the support with bolts (G).



Step 7

Still upside down, sit the frame (6) on top of the seat (6) and attach with screws (B) then attach stick-on floor protectors (F) to the bottom of each leg.
